Glyphosate, acetamiprid, captan, and tetrahydrophthalimide are pesticides that are sometimes used on crops in the United States. Glyphosate is also sometimes used as a drying agent—especially on wheat—in areas with shorter growing seasons. Food products may contain trace levels of glyphosate, acetamiprid, captan, and tetrahydrophthalimide, including some organic foods.

Recently, public interest groups have expressed concern about the possibility of trace levels of glyphosate, acetamiprid, captan, and tetrahydrophthalimide and their health effects in our pastas and apple juice. We do not add these pesticides or glyphosate as an ingredient in any of our products. Nonetheless, trace amounts of these pesticides may be found as the result of residual material contained in crop products that are used as ingredients in a finished product.

We regularly work with suppliers so that our products provide our customers with what they want to see in our products. So, we wanted to tell you that we hear you. We are committed to asking suppliers to look into ways to further reduce or eliminate glyphosate from our products.
